

South Dakota Board of Education
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at Northern State University, Student Center Centennial Rooms A & B West, 1200 South Jay Street, Aberdeen, South Dakota, Monday, March 20, 2017, at 11:30 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules:

§ 24:05:16:19 and 24:05:27:17 (Special Education);
§ 24:10:48:01 (CTE);
Article 24:15 (Certification);
§ 24:18:01:01 (Certificate Denial and Discipline procedures);
Article 24:28 (Educator Certification),
§ 24:43:10:01 and §§ 24:43:13 (Accreditation);
§ 24:53:02:01 (Program Approval)

The effect and purpose of changes to §§ 24:05:16:19 and 24:05:27:17 is to replace obsolete citations to Article 24:15 with citations to the updated certification requirements in Article 24:28.

The effect and purpose of changes to § 24:10:48:01 is to replace obsolete citations to Article 24:15 with citations to the updated certification requirements in Article 24:28.

The effect and purpose of changes to Article 24:15 is the repeal of existing certification rules made obsolete by the updated certification rules in Article 24:28. Rules regarding National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and National School Counselor certification will remain in the article. The reason for this rule change is to clean up rules that are no longer applicable due to the development of updated educator certification rules proposed in Article 24:28.

The effect of changes to § 24:18:01:01 is to replace obsolete citations to Article 24:15 with citations to the updated certification requirements in Article 24:28.

The effect and purpose of the Article 24:28 rules will be to update the state certification process for educators to: streamline the certification process; eliminate unnecessary barriers to the certification process; and ensure educators meet the minimum content and pedagogical knowledge requirements expected of them prior to being certified. The reason for adopting the Chapter 24:28 proposed rules is to create a state certification system for educators that more closely aligns with the realities of education in South Dakota and to improve outdated procedures and requirements. For the last two years, the Department of Education has been leading work groups through a comprehensive study of the current certification system and has identified areas in which conflicting rules and outdated requirements have created inefficiencies and unnecessary barriers both for candidates seeking to teach in the state and for schools desiring to hire educators. When adopted, these rules will ensure that applicants meet state requirements for the courses they teach or the leadership positions they hold, but will eliminate many of the inefficiencies and barriers identified by the workgroups.

This is the second of two public hearings held on Article 24:28 (Educator Certification).

The effect and purpose of changes to §24:43:10:01 is update references within the rule to the applicable preparation and certification requirements and remove language which limits

certificate holders based on school structure, in order to make the rule consistent with the updated certification rules in Article 24:28.

The effect and purpose of changes to Chapter 24:43:13 is to repeal the waiver route for noncertified administrators. Updated alternative certification pathways in Article 24:28 provide numerous certification options and eliminate the need for a waiver for noncertified administrators.

The effect and purpose of changes to § 24:53:02:01 is to replace obsolete citations to Article 24:15 with citations to the updated certification requirements in Article 24:28.
