The school health program in the South Dakota Departments of Education and Health in collaboration with Action For Healthy Kids will provide training on local school wellness policy. The training is being held in order to:

- help schools strengthen and effectively implement their wellness policies
- gain access to webinars, tools and tip sheets, and other resources

There is no registration fee for this training. School districts can request reimbursement for substitute teacher pay. Ideally, a team of at least two individuals from a school district will attend the training. Participants are asked to bring a hard copy of and/or have access to a Word document of the current school wellness policy. Participants will receive a certificate for 6 continuing education units (CEU's).
