Regular Early Childhood Program is a program that includes a majority (at least 50 percent) of non-disabled children (i.e. children not on IEP's). This category may include but is not limited to: Public or Private Kindergarten, public or private preschool programs, group child development centers or home-based child care.

If YES,
335 = Special Education Class (at least 50%) of children with disabilities (i.e. children on IEPs). This category may include but is not limited to programs in: Regular School Buildings, Trailers or Portables, Child care facilities, Hospital Facilities—out patient, Other community based settings.

345 = Separate School

designed for children with disabilities.

355 = Residential Facility

or medical facility (in patient)
